On April 13, 2010, officers from the Gulfport Police Department arrested 34 year old George William Aistrop of Long Beach and charged him with possession of a weapon after a felony conviction. Also arrested at the same time was 22 year old Ernest Dewayne Douglas of Gulfport and charged with disorderly conduct.

On April 13, 2010, at approximately 4:36 p.m. an officer from the Gulfport Police Department observed a Cadillac Escalade traveling west on Middle Drive with Douglas standing on the running board with the door open apparently in a physical altercation with Aistrop who was driving. As the vehicle came to a stop the officer restrained both individuals and Aistrop was found to be a felon in possession of a firearm. Aistrop had a felony conviction in South Carolina for fraud in 2004. Further investigation revealed that Aistrop and Douglas got into an altercation in the parking lot of Cellular South, located at Middle Drive and Three Rivers Road when Aistrop attempted to drive away with Douglas on the running board.

Upon completion of booking and processing Aistrop was transported to the Harrison County Adult detention facility in lieu of a \$5,000.00 bond set by Justice Court Judge Louise Ladner and Douglas was released on bond.
