On April 18, 2010, at approximately 11:00 p.m. the Gulfport Police Department arrested 29 year old Curtis C. Evans of Gulfport and charged him with simple robbery and indecent exposure.

On April 18, 2010, at approximately 10:49 p.m. officers from the Gulfport Police Department responded to 2013 31st Avenue for a report of simple robbery. Upon arrival it was learned that a driver for Domino's Pizza was assaulted and the suspect later identified as Evans was trying to take his wallet. Upon further investigation Evans was identified as the suspect and taken in to custody without incident in the 1300 block of Forest Avenue in Gulfport.

Upon booking and processing Evans began to masturbate in the holding cell and was also charged with indecent exposure. Evans was found to be on Post Release Supervision with the Mississippi Department of Corrections for a 2002 conviction of armed robbery and burglary where he was given sixteen years.

Upon the completion of booking and processing Evans was transported to the Harrison County Adult Detention Facility in lieu of a \$100,000.00 bond set by Justice Court Judge Louise Ladner and with a hold pending a revocation hearing of his Post Release Supervision.
