On April 23, 2010, the Gulfport Police Department arrested 51 year old black male Ronald D. McDonald, 45 year old white female Angelina Annesley and 34 year old black female Shajuana Washington all of Texas and charged them with three counts of uttering forgery.

The arrests stem from an investigation where Annesley entered Brooklyn's Pizzeria in Hardy Court and attempted to cash a counterfeit \$100.00 bill. An employee observed Annesley enter a vehicle and flee the scene. The employee contacted the Gulfport Police Department and gave a description of the vehicle.

Officers were able to locate the vehicle and conducted a traffic stop where Annesley was positively identified as the individual who attempted to pass the counterfeit currency. Also in the vehicle were McDonald and Washington.

Additional investigation revealed that Annesley passed additional counterfeit currency at two other locations. Also implicated in the printing of the counterfeit currency were McDonald and Washington. All three were placed into custody without incident.

All three were incarcerated at the Harrison County Adult Detention Center. McDonald's bond was set at \$60,000.00 and both Annesley and Washington's bond was set at \$50,000.00 by Harrison County Justice Court Judge Gene Dedeaux.

This case is still under investigation.
