On January 7, 2010, the Gulfport Police Department arrested 18 year old Robert E. Williams of Gulfport and charged him with two counts of burglary of a residence and on January 8, 2010 the Gulfport Police Department arrested 19 year old Desmond C. Durr Jr. of Gulfport and charged him with burglary of a residence.

Williams' first charge of burglary stems from the December 22, 2009, report of burglary in the 14500 block of Williamsburg Drive in which evidence was collected that connected Williams with the crime.

The second charge for Williams and subsequent arrest of Durr stem from the report of attempted burglary of a residence in the 1800 block of 20<sup>th</sup> Avenue on January 5, 2010. Both Williams and Durr were identified and connected to the burglary.

Upon review of the underlying facts and circumstances with Justice Court Judge Louise Ladner warrants were issued for both Williams and Durr with a bond of \$100,000.00 and \$50,000.00 respectively.

On January 7, 2010 Williams turned himself in on the outstanding warrant and on January 8, 2010, Durr also turned himself in on the outstanding warrant. Upon booking and processing both were transported to the Harrison County Adult Detention Facility in lieu of bond
