On July 21, 2010, the Gulfport Police Department arrested 19 year old Denman Crain Jr., 19 year old Gary Tyrone Noble, and 19 year old Jerry Jerome Noble of Gulfport and charged them all with one (01) count of burglary of a vehicle.

On July 13, 2010, at approximately 9:00 a.m. the Gulfport Police Department received a complaint of burglary of a vehicle in the 600 block of 26 ½ Street. During the course of the investigation Denman Crain, Gary and Jerry Noble were all positively identified as suspects. It was then discovered that Gary was out of jail on bond for a previous burglary charge through the City of Gulfport. Jerry was also found to be out on probation with the Mississippi Department of Corrections on a separate burglary conviction. After reviewing the underlying facts and circumstances a warrant was issued for their arrest.

On July 21, 2010, all three suspects were taken into custody at their residences without incident. Upon the completion of booking and processing all were transported to the Harrison County Adult Detention Facility in lieu of bond. Denman Crain's bond is set at \$5,000. Gary and Jerry Noble have bonds set at \$20,000 each.
