On July 20, 2010, the Gulfport Police Department arrested 21 year old Jeffrey Allen Newbury of Gulfport and charged him with three (03) counts of burglary.

On July 20, 2010 at approximately 2:00 a.m. officers from the Gulfport Police Department responded to the 800 block of Oakleigh Avenue for the report of vehicle burglaries which had just occurred. Upon arrival it was learned that Newbury had fled in a truck prior to the police arriving.

A short time later Newbury was stopped and taken into custody on a traffic stop in the area of Dedeaux Road and Lorraine Road still in possession of the stolen property. It was also found that Newbury was currently out on bond for fifteen (15) previous burglaries between the City of Gulfport and Harrison County.

Upon the completion of booking and processing Newbury was transported to the Harrison County Adult Detention Facility in lieu of a \$75,000.00 bond set by Justice Court Judge Gene Dedeaux pending the completion of his bond being revoked on the previous charges.
