On July 21, 2010, the Gulfport Police Department arrested 13 year old Noah Kaid Burge of Gulfport and charged him with two (02) counts of Aggravated Domestic Violence.

On July 20, 2010, at approximately 9:40 p.m. officers from the Gulfport Police Department responded to a residence on Banebury Cove for a report of a stabbing. Upon arrival the officers made contact with the two victims, Burge's Mother and Stepfather who were both suffering from multiple stab wounds. Both victims advised that Burge had stabbed them and fled the residence. Both victims were transported by ambulance to area hospitals.

On July 21, 2010, at approximately 12:14 a.m. Burge was located in the area of Mays Road and Easy Street where he was taken into custody without incident. Upon the completion of booking and processing Burge was transported to the Harrison County Adult Detention Facility in lieu of a \$200,000.00 bond set by Justice Court Judge Melvin Ray.
