On June 18, 2010, the Gulfport Police Department arrested 31 year old Creon Brown of Gulfport, and charged her with felony embezzlement.

On April 5, 2010, the Gulfport Police Department received a report from Clark Oil, located at 10015 Highway 49, that Brown had been stealing money which she had been entrusted to by virtue of her employment. Upon review of the underlying facts and circumstances with Justice Court Judge Gene Dedeaux he issued a warrant for Brown's arrest with a bond of \$10,000.00.

On June 18, 2010, Brown turned herself in to the Gulfport Police Department on the outstanding warrant without incident. Upon the completion of booking and processing Brown was transported to the Harrison County Adult Detention Facility in lieu of bond.

At the time of this arrest Brown was out on bond from a felony embezzlement charge in June of 2009 reported by Sams Club.
