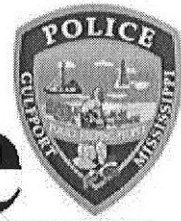

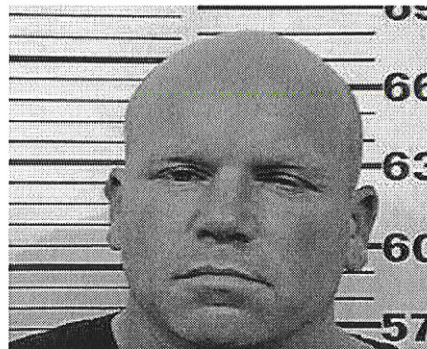

On March 22, 2010, the Gulfport Police Department arrested 48 year old white male Percy Roy Fayard, Jr. of Long Beach, and charged him with one count of burglary and one count of possession of methamphetamine.

The arrest stems from an investigation launched on March 14, 2010, where an individual broke into an empty building located in the 1800 block of 28th Street stealing pipe fittings and other plumbing materials from the property. Through the course of the investigation Fayard was developed as a suspect and arrest warrants were obtained.

On March 22, 2010, Fayard was located in the 2700 block of 25th Avenue where he was arrested for the outstanding warrant. During a search of Fayard methamphetamine was located on his person.

Fayard was incarcerated at the Harrison County Adult Detention Center in lieu of a \$20,000.00 bond for burglary set by Harrison County Justice Court Judge Melvin Ray and a \$25,000.00 bond set by Judge Gene Dedeaux for the methamphetamine.
