On May 13, 2010, the Gulfport Police Department arrested 18 year old Robert Earl Williams of Gulfport and charged him with burglary of a residence.

On April 21, 2010, officers responded to the 1000 block of Lewis Avenue for a report of burglary of a residence where the rear door had been kicked in. Upon further investigation it was found that that Williams was in possession of the stolen property. Upon reviewing the underlying facts and circumstances with Justice Court Judge Louise Ladner she issued a warrant for Williams' arrest with a bond of \$50,000.00.

On May 13, 2010, Williams was served with the outstanding warrant for burglary at the Harrison County Adult Detention Facility where he was being held on another count of burglary from Long Beach. Williams was out on bond for burglary at the time of this burglary and is being held pending a revocation of his bond.
