On May 27, 2010, the Gulfport Police Department arrested 25 year old Eddie Lee Farmer of Gulfport, 19 year old Tavarchie Roddre'Kuis Jones of Jackson, MS, and 19 year old Antwan Lavert Walker of Port Gibson, MS and charged them all with one (01) count of simple robbery.

On May 27, 2010, at approximately 9:00 a.m. officers from the Gulfport Police Department responded to the 3300 block of 39th Avenue for a report of a robbery which had just occurred. Upon arrival officers learned that three suspects later identified as Farmer Jones and Walker approached the victim and engaged him in conversation before assaulting him and stealing his wallet. The three then fled in a silver domestic vehicle south towards 28th Street.

While responding to the call an officer observed the suspect vehicle and stopped the vehicle in the 4000 block of 32nd Street. All suspects were taken into custody and the victim's property was recovered. Upon the completion of booking and processing all were transported to the Harrison County Adult Detention Facility in lieu of bond set by Justice Court Judge Gene Dedeaux. Farmer's bond was set at \$75,000.00, Jones's bond was set at \$25,000.00 and Walker's bond was set at \$25,000.00.
