On May 28, 2010, the Gulfport Police Department arrested 22 year old Milton Nathan Faulkner of New Orleans and charged him with four (04) counts of motor vehicle theft.

On May 28, 2010, at approximately 3:00 a.m. officers responded to the 900 block of Courthouse Road for a report of a motor vehicle theft that had just occurred. Upon arrival it was learned from a witness that a van had parked next to a motorcycle and when the van pulled away the motorcycle was missing.

Officers located the van traveling northbound on Highway 49 and attempted to stop the vehicle at Landon Road and Highway 49. The van continued north stopping in the area of St. Charles and Highway 49 where the driver, identified as Faulkner, jumped out and ran. Faulkner was then taken into custody after a short foot pursuit. Upon checking the van it was found to be stolen a short time earlier from the Best Western, located at 9475 Highway 49. The van was also found to contain three motorcycles which had all been stolen from 980 Courthouse Road.

Upon the completion of booking and processing Faulkner was transported to the Harrison County Adult Detention Facility in lieu of a \$45,000.00 bond set by Justice Court Judge Gene Dedeaux. This is an ongoing investigation.
